Rev. Ron joined the SHUMC staff as the Part-Time


Assistant Minister of Care on August 16, 2022. He comes to us with a wealth of experience in caring ministries and a passion for serving God and serving others.


LET'S TALK ABOUT HOSPICE **AND PALLIATIVE CARE**


