

Depression and Anxiety

Two of the most common mental health diagnoses in our nation are depression and

anxiety. According to the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), 25% of Americans have been diagnosed with depression and 25% of Americans have been given a diagnosis of anxiety. While medications can be used to treat these diagnoses, it is generally believed that medication without treatment, such as support groups, is only partially effective. Participating in a depression and anxiety group helps individuals understand that they are not alone in their depression or anxiety.

Complicated Grief

Many times bereaved people find that their grief is made more difficult by the circumstances surrounding the death of their loved one. This is called "complicated grief." Frequently, these circumstances involve suicide or homicide. Quickly, at the moment of death, law enforcement becomes involved hindering family members from entering their home or the hospital room. If the incident did not occur at home, the wounded person is taken to a hospital where both the nature of the injuries requiring intense medical intervention and the nature of the circumstances cause law enforcement to be engaged. These realities cause the family to be kept at a distance from their loved one. (Accidental deaths such as drowning can also create "complicated grief.") Persons experiencing complicated grief often need interventions and a level of understanding beyond those offered in most grief groups.

Complicated Grief – a support group for those whose lives have been impacted by suicide or the violent death of a loved one or friend.

Second and Fourth Mondays – 6:30 PM – 8:00 PM First Meeting – November 13

Pastor Ron will lead the Complicated Grief and Depression/Anxiety groups.

Pastor Ron Friesen is a specially trained bereavement counselor who has dealt with complicated grief in his own life, personally and professionally. With over 50 years of pastoral experience as well as 25 years of mental health experience, Pastor Ron has helped many individuals and families deal with complicated grief. His experience has been recognized in the community where he has trained over 700 individuals to work with grieving people.




The Mission Candle shines this week in celebration of Gretchen P. on her 87th birthday on October 10. Love, Paul.
